### ABOUT THE MAKEBA BUBBLY

The Makeba Bubbly, inspired by Mama Africa as a collaboration project with my Pinot Noir grape grower, embodies the spirit of Africa: Bright and Beautiful. These elements are also expressed by this Pinot Noir Bubbly with the heart behind this creation - simply to celebrate the meaning of Makeba: *To be absolutely magnificent in every aspect a human being can be.*

### MAKEBA PINOT NOIR BUBBLY 2014

Vineyards were planted in 2008 on the southwestern slopes of the Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge. These vineyards are approximately 10 km from the ocean and at an altitude of 300 m above sea level, enjoying the cool maritime influence. The soil is composed of Bokkeveld shale over a clay-rich substrate, ensuring sufficient moisture retention.

Harvest took place at the end of January 2014—a fairly wet and cooler year, ideal for early Pinot Noir picking intended for bubbly. The grapes were cooled overnight, and the following morning, they were whole-bunch pressed with gentle extraction, ensuring a beautiful rose-gold hue. The juice settled in a stainless steel tank, was racked, and then fermented. After primary fermentation, the wine was left on the lees for 9 months in stainless steel before being bottled for the second fermentation. The wine then spent a further 10 years on the lees. On the 29th of July 2024, we finally disgorged this beautiful bubbly.

### TASTING NOTES

A beautiful rose-gold hue. On the nose, you get hints of honeysuckle, with a lovely evolution of aromas into rich scents of hazelnuts and crème brûlée. The mousse is soft and creamy, offering a sensuous play on the palate. There is freshness combined with opulence, spice, and wonderful persistence.
